## Chaperone Statement

Please remember that you and / or your Clinician have the right to ask for a chaperone to be present at any time during your consultation. The chaperone may be a clinical or non-clinical member of staff who has received the appropriate training.

Roles of the Chaperone include:

- Ensuring the patients privacy and dignity is maintained
- Reassuring the patient
- Assisting / supporting the Clinician in the examination
- Support for the patient in understanding what is being said during the consultation
- Assisting to prepare for the examination
- Being present as a safeguard for all parties
